Minutes of the Annual General Meeting

Held at Manton Colliery Institute on Saturday 10th October 1953 2.45pm.

P Elliott proposed, seconded G Biggin that the Statement of Accounts be accepted.

P Elliott proposed, seconded A Nicholson that members not paying subscriptions be notified by post.

Election of Officers: President – G Biggin, Secretary – H Hind, Treasurer – V Todd

T Wild proposed, seconded G Biggin that the committee consist of six members from the Association and six from the Mansfield & District League, to be elected by the Mansfield members.

The following members were elected to the committee: Messrs Pike, Cuff, Elliott, Herbert, Ibberson and Clarke.

Proposed C Ibberson, seconded Cuf, that the Secretary be granted a Honarium of £5/5/0d.

P Elliott proposed, seconded Clarke, that the insurance policy re members be taken out for the coming season.

G Biggin proposed, seconded Cuff that N Pike be elected to sit on the Management Committee of the Bassetlaw League.

Proposed Clarke, seconded Wild, that A Ibberson and R Cuff be elected delegates to the Bassetlaw General meeting.

Correspondence were read from the Leicester Umpires. After a lengthy discussion it was left to Mr wild who said he would be going to represent the Association at the conference.

C Tyers was elected to represent the Association at the Annual Dinner of the Bassetlaw League.
